## 2022 South Dakota Hall of Fame Inductees



Jon Hunter succeeded his father and grandfather as publisher of the Madison Daily Leader and now joins both as a third-generation member of the South Dakota Newspaper Hall of Fame. Jon was publisher of the Daily Leader for 31 years before selling the newspaper and printing business in 2021. During his tenure he was noted for being devoted to his employees and to the community. Jon grew the family business, with almost one fifth of all weekly newspapers in the state printed at his central plant. Jon was president of SDNA in 1996-97. He has been active in support of Dakota State University and the South Dakota Heritage Fund, and he served as chairman of the South Dakota Investment Council.

This legislative session, Tim sponsored two important open government bills: one bill that modernized various laws for public notices and legal newspapers

and another bill that fixed a loophole in the executive session provisions of the open meetings laws. The inadvertent loophole was the result of an open meetings bill he sponsored in 2019. Tim agreed it needed to be addressed and was willing to sponsor legislation to address it. He worked well with all sides to see the bill become law.

The same is true for the public notices bill he sponsored this year. Tim has repeatedly supported the need for independent third-party publication of public notices while at the same time challenging newspapers to be pro-active to modernize various public notices laws. Again, he was instrumental in working with all sides to see the bill across the finish line this year.

Tim may be unique in the legislature in that he knows well the importance of balancing open government issues from the viewpoint of both a public official as well as that of the average citizen. His experience and his perspectives have made it possible for open government to be advanced in South Dakota.


